University of Connecticut Policy on Religious Observant Conflicts

REASON FOR POLICY

The University of Connecticut University Senate approved a policy and procedure for when a student experiences an academic conflict due to a religious observation. Statement must be added to the syllabus per University Senate.

POLICY STATEMENT

Students anticipating such a conflict regarding religious observances should inform their instructor in writing within the first three weeks of the semester, and prior to the anticipated absence, and should take the initiative to work out with the instructor a schedule for making up missed work.

ENFORCEMENT

Violations of this policy may result in appropriate disciplinary measures in accordance with University By-Laws, General Rules of Conduct for All University Employees, applicable collective bargaining agreements, and the University of Connecticut Student Code.
