Enrolling in PhD Courses as a Non-Matriculated Student

If you are contemplating doctoral study, we welcome you to consider enrolling in one of the courses this fall and spring as a non-matriculated student. You can take up to six credits as a non-matriculated student, and apply these toward your degree should you decide to apply and are accepted into the PhD program. This is an excellent way to explore the program and to think further about your own research ideas and directions.

Enrollment is contingent upon space available, and you must obtain the permission of the instructor in order to enroll. We also recommend that you contact a potential faculty advisor to discuss your ideas and goals prior to enrolling in courses. This person can be anyone on the faculty who shares a research interest in common with your goals for doctoral study.
