Title: Graduate Assistantship

The UConn School of Nursing is seeking a part-time Graduate Research Assistant for the 2019-2020 Academic Year for a project entitled "Adaptive Symptom Care Using Fish-Based Nutritional Directives Post Breast Cancer".

This candidate will travel between University of Connecticut Campus in Storrs to Hartford Hospital's Helen and Harry Gray Cancer center sites in Hartford and Avon conducting active research activities including patient recruitment, data collection, saliva specimen processing, data analysis and assistance with data reporting.

Requirements:

Minimum Qualifications:

College level 4 year degree. Background in health related field or nutritional sciences. Comfortable with patient care setting. Must be able to drive to Hartford to meet with patients and have flexibility in their schedule during the semester and winter/summer breaks.

Preferred Qualifications:

Experience with RedCap and SPSS.

Appointment: The candidate will devote 10 hours per week beginning August 23, 2019 through May 21, 2020. There is the potential to continue working on the project during summer 2020. The work schedule will be arranged with the project PI, Dr. Michelle Judge. The position will be on the UConn Storrs Campus and will require travel to Hartford Hospital.

There is the potential for mileage reimbursement to Hartford and Avon.
